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Below are some of the guidelines (visit kennelquilts.com for more details) if you wish to create some quilts ahead of Expo:

Materials should be 100% cotton & pre-washed.

When piecing, use a small stitch length (e.g. 14 stitches/inch).

Finished size should be 12" x 18" to fit the most commonly used small kennels at shelters.
