

The 2019 Sewing & Stitchery Expo

Online ticket sales will open **Tuesday**, **January 8th at 8:30am PST**. To access the online store, go to <u>sewexpo.com</u> and click on the yellow ticket icon that will be located in the main menu (see image below). For the smoothest experience purchasing tickets, please review the below changes and reminders.



Important Reminders for Purchasing Tickets Online

• Have a clear plan of action. Have a list of all the tickets you plan to purchase onhand. Watch this <u>video</u> for an example of how to keep yourself organized with helpful tips and tricks to make shopping online a breeze.

- Items will remain in your cart for 45 minutes. After 45 minutes have passed your cart will be emptied.
- There is a \$4.00 handling fee *per order*. To avoid multiple handling fees, have your complete list of desired tickets ready to avoid having to complete multiple orders.
- Make sure to have your credit hard on-hand!
- Take advantage of the search bar at the top of the page. Searching is the quickest
 and most direct way to find the class you want to add to your cart. If you know the
 exact class number, you can simply "search" that number to find the class and add it
 to your cart. You can also search by class title, teacher name, or event name.
- Double check your order before checking out to make sure you didn't forget anything or order too many of one ticket. Don't forget your admission and evening events tickets!
