Things to Know

What is Virtual Expo?

The Virtual Sewing & Stitchery Expo brings the best parts of Expo to your home or studio! The virtual platform is accessible via desktop, laptop, or smart phone. We know that virtual is a different way to do Expo, and we'll be there to help troubleshoot technological issues in every class and event during the show!

General admission is \$30 and includes access to the Virtual Expo platform for all five days of Expo, including the Virtual Vendor Floor, Free Stage classes, and daily entry in the machine door prize drawing! You can also purchase class and event tickets to complete your Expo experience.

To participate in classes, interactive virtual vendor booths, and the Free Stage, you will need to sign up for a free Zoom account, have a computer or phone with the Zoom app installed and updated to the latest version, and a high-speed internet connection; tablets are not recommended. The virtual platform will be available starting in February.

Whether you want a 45-minute introduction or a 2.5-hour or 4-hour dive into a project, there is a Virtual Expo class for you. All One Needle classes—and those marked *"All skill levels"*—are a great place to dip your toe in and gain confidence! Perfect your skills with classes marked *"Intermediate."* All purchased classes will be recorded and will remain available for 30 days after Virtual Expo. *Items with a button* (③) *next to them have been updated since original publication.*

Project Kits. Where required, project-specific kits will be available for purchase directly from your instructors' website or store. Listed kit fees may not include shipping. Information on how to purchase kits will be provided along with your registration. *Registration for kit classes is strongly recommended by February 4 to allow time for shipping. Registering after this date may result in kits not arriving prior to Expo.*

Student Supplies. Additional materials listed under Student Supplies are the responsibility of the student. We recommend students in hands-on classes also prepare a work area with good task lighting, and select a stable, easily visible location for their device. *Please note: Some classes may require a sewing machine, serger, or other sewing tool. These will be noted in the class description. Make sure you come to class with your sewing machine or serger ready to sew.*

Basic Sewing Supplies. Some classes include *"Basic Sewing Supplies"* under Student Supplies. Students should have these items ready for use (see list below Three and Four Needle class descriptions). You can purchase supplies from the retailer of your choice. A list of Virtual Expo vendors is available on page 33.

Homework. Some classes may also require prep work before class time. If there is homework indicated in the catalog, it is a general outline of tasks required for each class. Full instructions, if necessary, will be sent to students after registration.
